The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspects who robbed a letter carrier in the vicinity of 22731 Del Valle Street, Woodland Hills, CA, 91364. The robbery occurred at or around 3:00 p.m. on January 25, 2020. Postal Inspectors are seeking two suspects who are described as Hispanic males that were seen in a 2007 to 2010 white GMC Yukon with dark tinted windows. The vehicle was used in the commission of the crime. A sketch of suspect #1, surveillance footage of suspect #2, and surveillance footage of the white GMC Yukon used in the robbery are pictured above.
