ASSAULTS OF USPS LETTER CARRIERS



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) who assaulted multiple USPS Letter Carriers with a paintball gun in and around Washington, DC on May 23, 2020.

The assaults occurred at the following approximate times and locations:

- 3:15pm on the 4800 block of B St. SE, Washington, DC.
- 4:30pm on the 3900 block of 1st St. SW, Washington, DC.
- 4:30pm on the 100 block of Irvington St. SW, Washington, DC.
- 5:30pm on the 5800 block of Quintana St., Riverdale, Maryland.
- 6:15pm on the 1200 block of 46th St. SE, Washington, DC.

The unknown subject(s) are described as:

- 1) African American male in his twenties, 5'10" to 6' tall, slim build with braids/dreads wearing a white shirt.
- 2) African American male with a slim build.

The vehicle the subject(s) drove is described as a silver or dark gray four-door sedan bearing temporary tags.
