ATTEMPTED ARMED ROBBERY OF A LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspects who attempted to rob a letter carrier at gunpoint at the 600 E. Jefferson Avenue block in Pomona, California on May 29, 2020, at approximately 11:00AM.

Postal Inspectors are seeking two suspects described as young black males of thin build. The suspects were in an older model silver Toyota Corolla (actual suspect vehicle pictured above) that has damage on the right front bumper, no front or rear license plates, and was described as having a loud engine.

Suspect 1: Approximately 5'7", 19-22 years old, wearing a blue bandana face covering
Suspect 2: Approximately 5'3", wearing a mask
