Up to \$10,000 BURGLARY OF POST OFFICE



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the burglary of the Copper Queen Post Office in Bisbee, AZ.

Postal Inspectors seek the public's assistance in identifying those responsible for breaking into the U.S. Post Office located at 6 Main Street, Bisbee, AZ 85603. This incident occurred between 10:30 PM and 11:00 PM on Saturday, June 6, 2020.

Burglary of a post office is a federal offense under Title 18, United States Code, Section 2115. Persons convicted of this charge may face up to five years in federal prison and fines of up to \$250,000.
