ROBBERY OF U.S. POSTAL SERVICE LETTER CARRIER

The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) who robbed a U.S. Postal Service letter carrier on Thursday, June 4, 2020, at approximately 9:30 p.m., on the 3500 block of Hayes Street NE, Washington, DC 20019.

Three suspects involved in the robbery were identified with the following descriptions:

Suspect #1 – Black male, dark complexion, possibly late teens or early 20s, 5'2" – 5'3", thin build, possibly weighing 140 – 150 pounds, black hair faded on sides of head with more natural looking hair on top. Reflective jacket, black "skinny" jeans, black tennis shoes, with a surgical face mask.

Suspect #2 – Black male, dark complexion, possibly late teens or early 20s, 5'3", thin build, possibly weighing 140 – 150 pounds. Black hoodie, black sweat pants, black Nike boots, with a surgical face mask.

Suspect #3 – Black male, older than Suspects 1 and 2. Bright-colored sweatshirt (i.e. possibly yellow or orange) with front pocket section, dark colored shorts.
