REWARD

Up to \$50,000 ROBBERY OF A LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect who assaulted and robbed a U.S. Postal Service (USPS) Letter Carrier at 701 W. 13th Street, Tempe, AZ 85281.

The incident occurred, at approximately 1:15 P.M., on February 24, 2021.

The suspect is described as a white male with brown hair and brown eyes, approximately 5'10" tall, and weighing approximately 160 pounds. The subject was wearing a black sweater and blue jeans. The suspect was believed to be the passenger of a gray, four-door sedan (pictured above).

Assault of a USPS employee and theft of U.S. Mail are federal offenses under Title 18, United States Code, Sections 111 and 1708, respectively. Persons convicted on the above charges may face up to 20 years in federal prison.
