## Up to \$50,000

### ASSAULT OF A LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect who assaulted a U.S. Postal Service Letter Carrier at 740 Durham Drive, North Salt Lake City, UT 84054.

The incident occurred at approximately 1:10 P.M. on March 14, 2021.

The suspect is described as a male, possibly a Pacific Islander. He was driving a blue Honda CR-V with a Utah license plates beginning with W15 (pictured above).

Assault of a U.S. Postal Service employee while performing their official duties is a federal offense under Title 18, United States Code, Section 111. A person convicted on this charge may face up to 20 years in federal prison
