ASSAULT OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER

The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect responsible for the assault of a U.S. Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier near the intersection of W Prospector Way and N Archway Dr, San Tan Valley, AZ 85142.

The incident occurred at approximately 2:00 P.M. on May 8, 2021.

The suspect is described as a white male, possibly in his 40s or 50s.

Assault of a U.S. Postal Service employee while engaged in the performance of their official duties is a federal offense under Title 18, United States Code, Section 111. Persons convicted on this charge may face up to 20 years in federal prison.
