ROBBERY OF USPS DRIVER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspects who robbed a United States Postal Service (USPS) driver near the 1000 block of Connecticut Ave. NW, Washington, DC 20036.

The incident took place, at approximately 5:50 P.M., on June 1, 2021.

Two subjects, dressed in construction-style clothing (pictured above), approached and robbed the USPS driver. The subjects fled the scene in an old silver Mercedes sedan with Maryland tags and a dark-colored front passenger-side fender (pictured above).
