ARMED ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspects who robbed a U.S. Postal Service (USPS) Letter Carrier at the intersection of Dinkle Rd. and Quail Trail, Edgewood, NM 87015.

The incident occurred at approximately 12:05 P.M. on August 10, 2021.

The suspects are described as male, both approximately 5'9" tall, wearing the same bandanna face masks, black T-shirts, black pants, and black ball caps. The suspects were driving a white 4-door sedan (pictured above), with an Arizona partial license plate of 'CWH99.'

The suspects were armed with a handgun at the time of the incident and should be considered armed and dangerous.
