BURGLARY OF U.S. POST OFFICE



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) who committed a string of U.S. Post Office burglaries along Interstates I-76, I-25, and I-80 near the adjoining borders of Colorado, Wyoming, and Nebraska. The burglaries occurred between approximately 6:30 P.M. on August 6, 2021 and 10:00 A.M. on August 8, 2021. The suspect is believed to be driving a navy blue 2001-07 Dodge Caravan (or similar) with both rear side windows broken (pictured above, middle).

The suspect (pictured above) was involved with the burglary of the Cheyenne Main Post Office, 4800 Converse Ave., Cheyenne, WY 82009 at approximately 7:15 P.M. on August 6, 2021. The suspect is described as a white male, 20 to 30 years of age, with bushy dark-blond hair, a blond goatee, of average build, with a vertical tattoo on the outside of his lower right leg.
