ARMED ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect who robbed a United States Postal Service (USPS) Letter Carrier in the vicinity of 14113 Downey Ave., Paramount, CA 90723. The robbery occurred at approximately 10:15 A.M. on February 12, 2022.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male in his late 20s, approximately 5'10" tall and 190 lbs., with short dark hair. The suspect along with an unknown accomplice fled west on Rosecrans Ave., Paramount, CA, in a white sedan (pictured on the right), possibly a Chevrolet Malibu.

The suspect was armed with a handgun at the time of the incident and should be considered armed and dangerous.
