ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER

The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) involved in two armed robberies of United States Postal Service (USPS) Letter Carriers in the city of Moreno Valley, CA occurring on March 16, 2022, at approximately 9:35 A.M., and on April 7, 2022, at approximately 9:28 A.M.

The suspect is described as a Black male, early teens to 18 years of age, approximately 5'6" tall and 160 pounds. The suspect was wearing a blue or black hooded sweatshirt and dark pants on March 16, 2022, and wearing a dark hat, black t-shirt, and dark pants on the April 7, 2022. The suspect brandished a handgun.

Postal Inspectors are asking anyone with information about these robberies to please contact them.

The suspect should be considered armed and dangerous.
