ARMED ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect involved in the armed robbery of a United States Postal Service (USPS) Letter Carrier in the 300 block of East Virgin Street Tulsa, OK 74106.

The incident occurred at approximately 10:30 A.M. on June 6, 2022.

The suspect, pictured above, is described as a young Black male, approximately 5' 7" tall with a slender build. He was wearing a dark blue hooded sweatshirt with white stripes on the side of both the jacket and pants.

Postal Inspectors are asking anyone with information about this robbery to please contact them.

The suspect should be considered armed and dangerous.
