Up to \$50,000 Robbery of USPS Letter Carrier

The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) who robbed a United States Postal Service (USPS) Letter Carrier at gunpoint.

On Wednesday, October 26, 2022, at approximately 7:45 p.m., an unknown suspect pointed a black handgun at the Letter Carrier in the 3700 block of Eudora Street in Denver, CO. The suspect stole Postal Service assets and fled on foot.

The suspect is described as a white male, approximately 30 to 40 years old, medium build, 5'8" to 5'10" tall, wearing a gray-hooded sweatshirt. The suspect wore a cloth face mask with a "mouth" image on it.

The suspect also may have tattoos visible on both hands and on his upper face. The tattoos on his hands were described as having stars in them.
