ARMED ROBBERY OF USPS EMPLOYEE

The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect responsible for the armed robbery of a USPS Letter Carrier on November 17, 2022, in the vicinity of N 18th & Ocean Street, Palatka, FL 32177.

Suspect is described as a Black male, 6'0"-6'2" tall, with a medium build, wearing a black-hooded sweatshirt, dark pants, black "Neck Gator," and dark-colored sunglasses.

Armed robbery of a postal employee is a violation of Title 18, U.S. Code Section 2114, and is punishable by up to 25 years in prison.
