ATTEMPTED ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) for attempted robbery of a USPS letter carrier that occurred on Monday January 30, 2023, at approximately 2:45 p.m., in the 100 block of S. Sherry Avenue, Norman, OK 73069.

The suspect is described as a Black male, slender, approximately 5'9" tall, in his mid 20s, wearing a black beanie, red bandanna on his face, gray hoodie, and armed with a knife.

The suspect(s) fled in a newer crimson Mercury Milan sedan as seen in the picture above.

Postal Inspectors are asking anyone with information about this attempted robbery to please contact them.

The suspect should be considered armed and dangerous.
