ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspects who attempted to rob a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier in the Joslin Grove Park subdivision near 237 Lake Dr, Orlando, FL 32835 at approximately 3:30PM on January 27, 2023.

Later the same day, the suspects then robbed a USPS letter carrier near 641 Altamira Circle, Altamonte Springs, FL 32701 at approximately 4:30PM. The suspects were seen driving a newer black Volkswagen Tiguan (pictured above).

One of the suspects, pictured above, was seen driving the suspect vehicle on Saturday, February 4th at the Wawa on Orange Blossom Trail & Colonial Dr., Orlando, FL.

The suspects are described as Black males, wearing gray and black hooded sweatshirts, and black masks.
