ARMED ROBBERY OF USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect who robbed a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier. The incident took place at approximately 4:33 p.m., on Friday, September 1, 2023, near 15111 Pond Village Drive, in the Pond Village apartments, Taylor, MI.

The suspect was described as an African American male wearing a black-hooded sweatshirt and black surgical mask. The individual was approximately 5'8" to 5'10" tall, in his 20s, weighing approximately 190 lbs., and armed with a black semi-automatic pistol. After committing the robbery, the suspect fled in a black 4-door sedan (pictured above) heading east on Pond Village Drive.
