BURGLARY OF A POST OFFICE & THEFT OF MAIL



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$100,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the above suspect(s) who stole U.S. Mail on two separate occasions.

The first incident was on October 31, 2023, when the above suspect(s) entered a UPS Store in Wildomar, CA. The suspect pictured above (left), posed as a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier, and took outgoing U.S. Mail.

The second incident occurred on November 6, 2023, when the suspect pictured above (right), entered a Post Office in Oak View, CA, posed as a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier, and took U.S. Mail.

Additional attempts to steal U.S. Mail were made at multiple Post Offices in Riverside, Norco, and Corona. The vehicle used in these incidents is pictured above. The vehicle is described as a gray Dodge Challenger with decorative American Flag license plates.
