ARMED ROBBERY OF USPS LETTER CARRIERS



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspects responsible for robbing two different U.S. Postal Service (USPS) letter carriers in the Montbello neighborhood in Denver.

On March 4, 2024, at approximately 5:00 p.m., two suspects robbed a letter carrier on the 4600 block of Eureka Court.

A short time later the same suspects robbed a different letter carrier at Bolling Drive and Duluth Court.

The suspects fled in a white car pictured above, driven by the third suspect.
