The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$100,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) who burglarized four post offices in Eastern Kansas.

The first burglary occurred between the hours of 4:30 p.m. on April 4, 2024 and 8:30 a.m. on April 5, 2024 at the post office located at 102 N Center St, Parker, KS 66072.

The second burglary occurred at the post office located at 112 4th Avenue, Bucyrus, KS 66013, between the hours of 11:15 a.m., on April 6, 2024 and 7:45 a.m. on April 8, 2024.

The third burglary occurred at the post office located at 416 S Kansas Avenue, Lane, KS 66042, between 12:30 p.m. on April 6, 2024 and 7:50 a.m. on April 8, 2024.

The fourth burglary occurred at the post office located at 106 E. Main St., Rantoul, KS 66079, between 3:00 p.m. April 6, 2024 and 7:50 a.m. on April 8, 2024.
