- PROTECTING U.S. POSTAL SERVICE® EMPLOYEES AS THEY DELIVER ELECTION MAIL
- PROTECTING ELECTION OFFICIALS FROM THREATENING OR DANGEROUS MAIL

STEALING ELECTION MAIL, EVEN IF INCIDENTAL TO THE THEFT OF THE MAIL, IS A FEDERAL OFFENSE WHICH IS **PUNISHABLE BY UP TO FIVE (5) YEARS IN PRISON.**

ATTACKS AGAINST OR ROBBERY OF USPS® EMPLOYEES CAN INTERFERE WITH THE DELIVERY OF ELECTION MAIL SUCH AS MAIL-IN BALLOTS, AND IS A FEDERAL OFFENSE WHICH IS **PUNISHABLE BY UP TO 10 YEARS IN PRISON.**

MAILING DANGEROUS ITEMS OR SUBSTANCES TO ATTACK, INTIMIDATE, OR THREATEN AN ELECTION OFFICIAL IS ALSO A FEDERAL OFFENSE WHICH IS **PUNISHABLE BY UP TO 20 YEARS IN PRISON.**
