## Up to \$150,000

### ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect, pictured above, in an armed robbery of a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier. The incident occurred on June 28, 2024, at approximately 1:20 p.m., in the vicinity of 5050 S. Evans Ave., Chicago, IL 60615. The suspect fled towards E. 51st Street.

The suspect is described as a Black female, approximately 5'6"- 5'7" tall, and approximately 20-25 years of age. The suspect was wearing a pink shower cap, white face mask, blue jean jacket with a pink sweatsuit underneath, with large false eyelashes. The suspect should be considered armed and dangerous.
