### ROBBERY OF USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) wanted in connection to the robbery of a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier.

The incident occurred on Friday, October 4, 2024, at approximately 10:38 a.m. in the 6900 block of Woodlake Drive, Memphis TN 38119, inside The Park at New Castle Apartments.

The suspect, pictured above, is described as a Black male, late teens to early 20's, approximately 5'10" tall, approximately 190 lbs, regular build, and dark brown complexion. The suspect was wearing a black hoodie, black jeans, black face mask, black gloves, and black shoes. The suspect was seen occupying the later model black Nissan Altima pictured above.
