Up to \$150,000 ROBBERY OF USPS LETTER CARRIER







The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) responsible for the attempted armed robbery of a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier on October 30, 2024, at approximately 5:40 p.m. near 653 S Emerson St, Denver, CO 80209.

The suspect is described as a Black male wearing a balaclava covering his face, a dark blue hooded sweatshirt and black pants. The suspect fled by foot north on S Emerson Street.

A blue four-door sedan with black wheels, pictured above, was seen in the area of the robbery prior to the incident and may have been involved.
