Up to \$150,000 ROBBERY OF USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect who robbed a USPS letter carrier at approximately 6:30 p.m., on October 31, 2024.

The incident occurred while the letter carrier was delivering mail to a mailbox near 2202 Valentia St., Denver, CO 80238. The suspect, is described as a Black male wearing a hooded sweatshirt, sweatpants, and a face covering. The suspect fled west on foot.

The vehicle, pictured above, may be associated with this robbery.
