ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspects who robbed multiple United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carriers on November 25, 2024, in Louisville, Kentucky.

The first incident occurred at approximately 12:02 p.m., near 3019 Hartlage Ct, Louisville, KY 40216. The second incident occurred at approximately 12:20 p.m., near 2400 Crittenden Dr, Louisville, KY 40217. The third incident followed at approximately 12:30 p.m., near 1335 Cypress St, Louisville, KY 40211.

The suspect(s) are described as three Black males wearing black clothing and were seen driving a white Audi sedan with a stolen Kentucky license plate. The photo above is from the second robbery that occurred near 2400 Crittenden Drive.
