BURGLARIES OF PLANO POST OFFICES



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$100,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspects who burglarized the Plano, TX Main Post Office and Plano Wildcat Post Office.

Overnight between April 5th and 6th, 2025, the Plano Main Post Office, located at 1200 Jupiter Road, Plano, TX 75074 and the Plano Wildcat Post Office, located at 2901 W. Parker Road, Plano, TX 75023, were burglarized.

The first suspect is described as a male, wearing a black cowboy hat, black shirt, camouflage pants, white gloves and a mask (photographed above, left).

The second suspect is described as a heavy set Black male, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with a pink logo, beanie with a white square logo, black pants, and brown shoes (photographed above, right).
