ROBBERY OF A LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the identification, arrest, and conviction of the suspect(s) who robbed a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier.

The robbery took place on Tuesday, February 18, 2025, at approximately 2:00 p.m., when at least two suspects in a white SUV, pictured above, robbed the letter carrier in the 9900 block of Broad Street, Bethesda, Maryland 20814.

The vehicle was last seen fleeing westbound on Lone Oak Drive Bethesda, MD 20814.

The US Postal Inspection Service is seeking any information, to include video footage, and the identity of the suspect occupants regarding this incident.
