The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$100,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of fugitive Robert Cooper III, pictured above, related to multiple mail theft incidents in Houston, Harris County, Texas.

Robert Cooper III, described as a white male, is a wanted fugitive with an active 1st degree felony warrant. He was in possession of approximately 1000 pieces of stolen mail containing victims' personal identifiable information, credit/debit cards, checks, and counterfeit postal arrow keys.
