ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) involved in the robbery of a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier. The incident occurred on December 4, 2025, at approximately 3:46 p.m., near 229 Parkdale Ave, Buffalo, NY 14213.

Suspect 1 is described as a Black male, approximately 5'10", slim build, wearing a black hoodie with an Adidas logo on the front, black pants with white/grey stripe on the outside thigh stopping at the knee.

Suspect 2 is described as a Black male, approximately 6'0", slim build, wearing all black hoodie and pants, with a black ski mask.

The suspects robbed the carrier at gun point and were last seen fleeing on foot through backyards in the vicinity of 47 Greenwood Place in Buffalo.
