ROBBERY OF A USPS LETTER CARRIER



The U.S. Postal Inspection Service is offering a reward of up to \$150,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) involved in the robbery of a United States Postal Service (USPS) letter carrier. The incident occurred on May 9, 2025, at approximately 6:35 p.m., while the carrier was delivering mail near 1317 Center St, Oakland, CA 94607.

The suspect was described as a Black male wearing a zip-up hooded sweatshirt and mask. He was approximately 5'7" with a slim build. The getaway vehicle was possibly a two-door Honda.
